

Wingspread is about five miles north at 33 E. 4 Mile Road, Racine, WI 53402.









The Research Tower (1950) is one of the tallest structures ever built on the cantilever principle. It stands 153 feet tall and its central core, which is 13 feet in diameter, extends 54 feet into the ground. All 15 floors are supported by its core.





The SC Johnson Administration Building (1939) was the first creation Frank Lloyd Wright designed for SC Johnson. Here, you'll find the famed Great Workroom with its soaring dendriform columns.



ADD A VISIT TO WINGSPREAD

Tour the iconic, Prairie-style home Frank Lloyd Wright designed for SC Johnson's third-generation leader, H.F. Johnson, Jr.

Located just five miles north of SC Johnson headquarters, **Wingspread** (1939) is the last and largest of Wright's Prairie-style homes.

This free tour highlights remarkable features in the 14,000-square-foot house such as the disappearing dining table, a teepee-inspired clerestory ceiling in the great room and the cantilevered "Romeo and Juliet" balcony bedroom.
