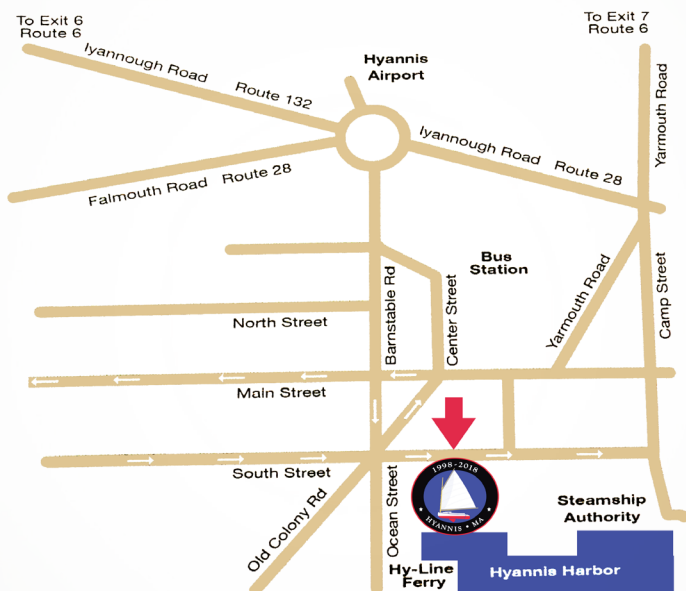




## Explore the rich maritime history of Cape Cod
