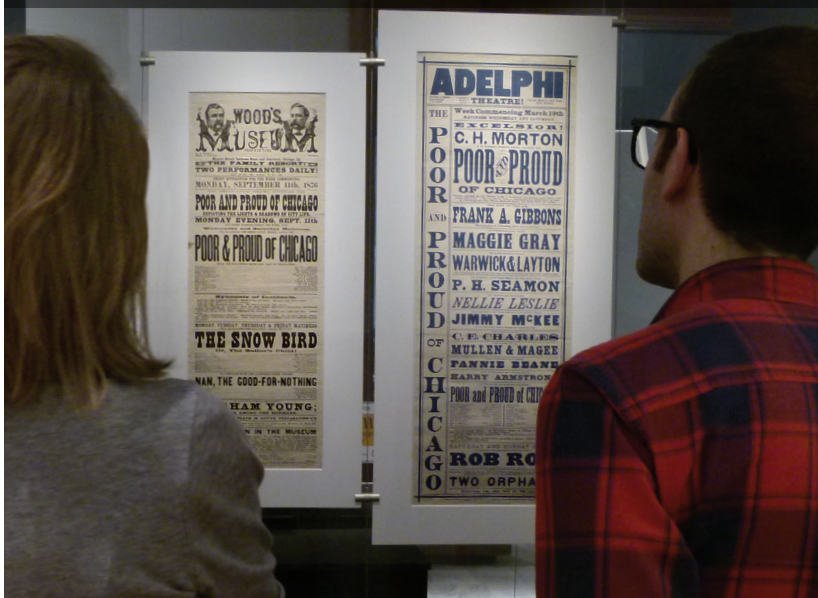


See something new from the past
