Visit maritime New London, a 19th-century whaling port, site of the Amistad affair, historic lighthouses, and home of the U. S. Coast Guard Academy, and modern submarine industry.

We're open year-round. Browse permanent & special exhibitions on your own or join a tour.

Tour *inside* a lighthouse - we own 3! New London Harbor *Pequot* Light, New London Ledge, and Race Rock Light. Come on a sunset or full moon lighthouse boat trip.

DIRECTIONS: located two blocks from the rail/bus/ferry transportation center in New London's downtown historic district. Designed in 1833 by architect Robert Mills, this is the oldest continuously-operated custom house in the country. Handicap accessible on lower level, only.
