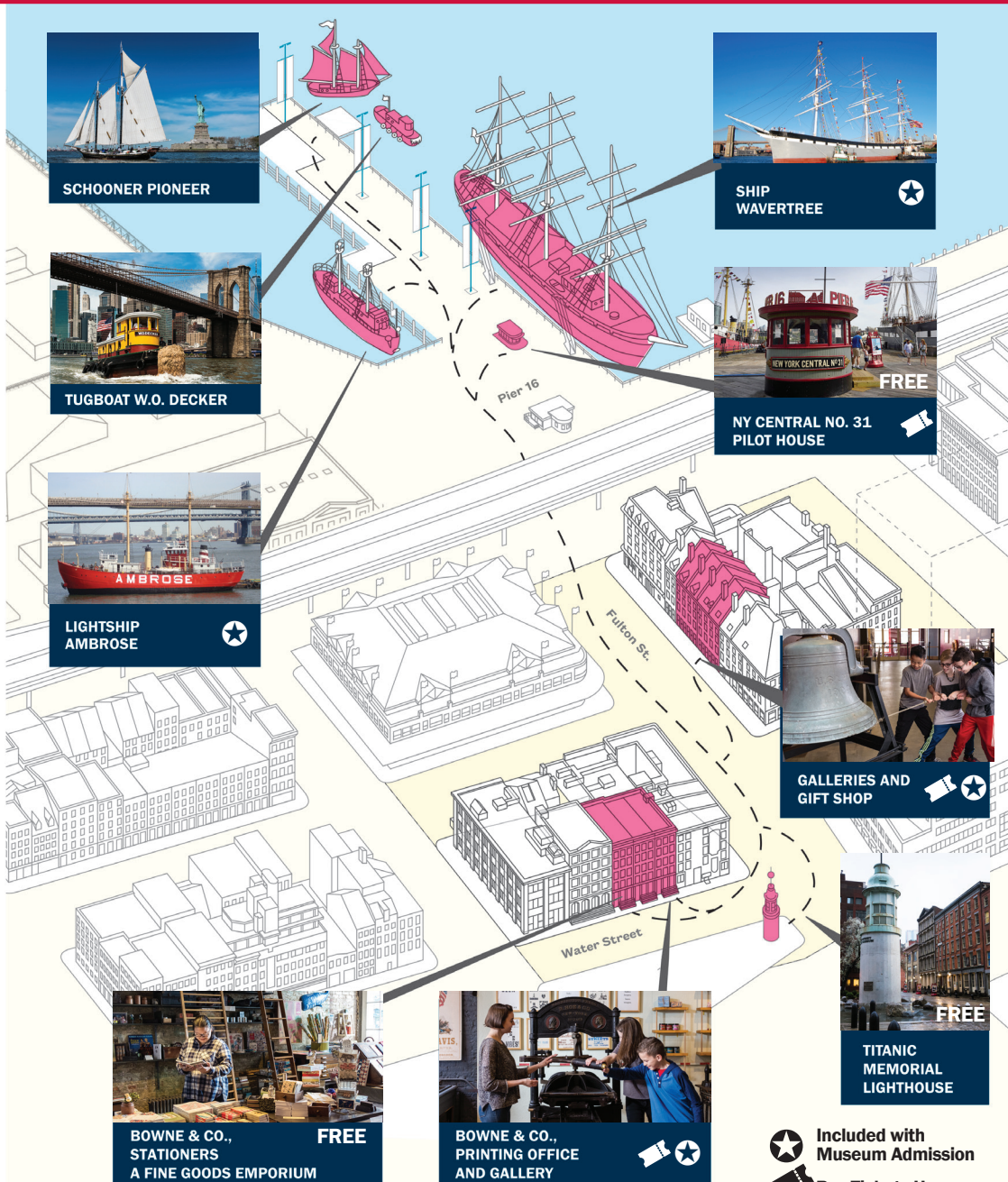
SOUTH STREET SEAPORT MUSEUM

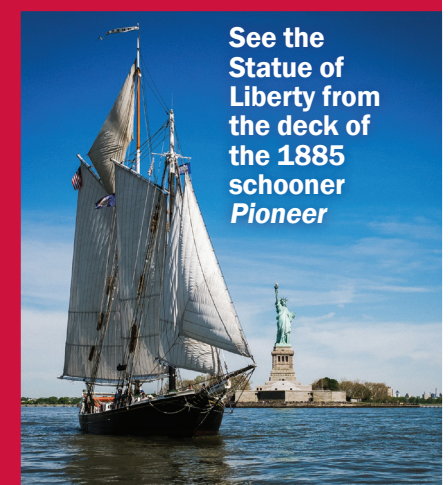
