The Harry S. Truman Presidential Library and Museum is undergoing a massive transformation of the museum and its exhibitions, the first major renovation in more than 20 years and the largest since the museum opened its doors in 1957. The museum is currently closed to the public to make this renovation possible, with plans to reopen in 2020.
