Annually thousands of visitors from throughout the region come to GARNER to experience its cutting-edge art, participate in one of the largest arts festivals in the region, visit working artist studios, walk its Creekside Sculpture Trail, dine & taste craft beer brewed on-site, all while admiring the vast 19th century brick facades and alleyways filled with art. GARNER is only 30 miles north of New York City, a brief ferry ride from Westchester County and a quick drive from destinations in the Mid-Hudson Valley.
