Things to do at Loggerhead Marinelifelife Center:

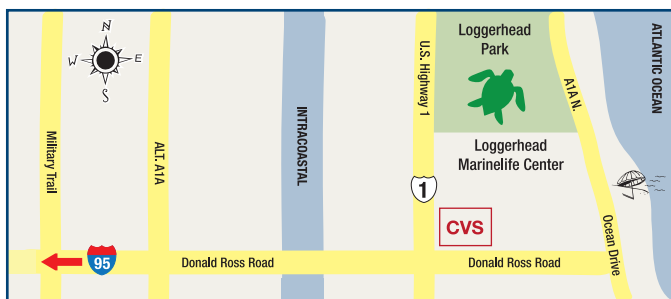
- Interactive exhibit hall with educational, hands-on displays
