DIRECTIONS:

Located on the Delaware River, across from Center City Philadelphia, on the southern end of the Camden Waterfront, near the New Jersey State Aquarium and Tweeter Center. Tours will require climbing ladders and walking through quarters just like it did for the crew when the "Big J" was commissioned. We recommend wearing comfortable walking or athletic shoes and dress casual. Many bags are not permitted on the battleship. These can be securely stowed at the landside Visitor Center.
