

OPEN AIR TRAM TOURS

Board our open air trams and let the National Park Service trained naturalists escort you on a memorable journey through Shark Valley. Gain insight into this unique ecosystem and witness abundant wildlife such as the American Alligator, a large variety of birds, turtles, fish and other species in their natural habitat.

During your tour enjoy a birds eye view of the grandeur that is the Everglades from the 45 foot Observation Tower at the half way point of the 15 mile journey.

BIKE RENTALS

A self-guided bicycle tour is a wonderful way to conduct your own Everglades ecotour. The flat 15 mile paved road is ideal for a leisurely ride, and free of rough terrain. A typical ride takes between 2 and 3 hours.

Rental bikes are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and a driver's license or ID is required to rent bikes. All of our rentals are single gear, cruiser style models with adjustable seats to accommodate riders of different heights. Baskets and helmets are available for all rental bikes. In addition, we have children's bikes and bikes with child seats for children of 35 pounds or less.
