

VIZCAYA MUSEUM AND GARDENS

Enjoy a little slice of Europe in Miami.

It was 1914 when wealthy, retired industrialist James Deering began to build his magnificent estate in the subtropical forest along the shores of Biscayne Bay. Inspired by eighteenth-century Italian villas, his vision included adapting northern Italian-Mediterranean style architecture to Miami's subtropical climate.

Filled with art, furniture, wall coverings and architectural elements from the past, and surrounded by 10 acres of European-inspired formal gardens, this Gilded Age estate is a National Historic Landmark and one of South Florida's most popular and enduring destinations.





Vizcaya is conveniently located with easy access from the beaches, downtown, Brickell, Coconut Grove, Coral Gables, Miami, Ft. Lauderdale, Broward and Palm Beach counties. It can be accessed by Metrorail, Trolley, bus and ride-sharing services and also offers ample onsite parking and bike-racks.
